




The Fishermen's Trail at Star Fort Pond


Rules and Regulations

Fishing is allowed at the Star Fort Pond from dawn to dusk on Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays from April 1 to November 1. Anglers 16 years or older must possess a valid South Carolina fishing license. Daily limits are twenty bream, three channel catfish, and three largemouth bass (twelve inch minimum length). Snagging of fish and fishing with live minnows is not permitted. Alcoholic beverages and firearms of any kind are not permitted on the lake property.


