


McAlester Lake / South Pass



STATE ROUTE 20 from trailhead:
53 mi / 85 km west to Marblemount,
33 mi / 53 km east to Winthrop

A Northwest Forest Pass or federal recreation access pass is required to park, and is available at any ranger station.

3.1 mi / 5 km from trailhead to Fireweed Camps (junction with Twisp Pass Trail)

4.5 mi / 7.2 km from Bridge Creek crossing to McAlester Lake

0.7 mi / 1.1 km from McAlester Pass to Hidden Meadows

1.4 mi / 2.3 km from South Pass to McAlester Pass (High Camp)

7.3 mi / 11.8 km from Twisp River Road to South Pass

RAINBOW CREEK TRAIL from High Camp to the Stehekin Vally Road: 9.7 mi / 15.6 km

TWISP RIVER ROAD: 22 mi / 35.4 km to Twisp from South Creek trailhead

-  Designated hiker camp. Camping is allowed only where specified on your backcountry permit, at areas shown on the map.
 -  Designated stock camp. Camping is allowed only where specified on your backcountry permit, at areas shown on the map.
 -  Leashed pets are allowed only within the Lake Chelan National Recreation Area (pets cannot enter via State Route 20, Bridge Creek Trail).
 -  PROPER FOOD STORAGE IS ESSENTIAL. Never leave food unattended whether day hiking or camping. If camping overnight, take a bear canister or properly hang food/trash/toiletries. Keep a clean camp and do not feed the wildlife.
 -  Fires are not permitted at High Camp.
 -  Hunting is allowed in season in the Lake Chelan Recreation Area. Washington State hunting and fishing regulations apply. Hunting is not allowed in North Cascades National Park.
