Job Description: Tasks may include conducting tours and presentations about the park's natural and/or cultural resources; conducting informal interpretation, conveying park rules and regulations to park visitors; assisting with visitor center and campground operations, special events, publicity, signage, maintenance of displays/exhibits, collection and documentation of visitor program statistics. Other tasks may include administrative functions, light trail work, gardening and working with volunteers.

Qualifications: **Students must be able to follow directions, participate in education and environmental training, overnight trips and must work well with others. Students must have an interest in working in the environment/ outdoors, learning about history and building public speaking skills.**
