In the original nomination for the Central High School Neighborhood Historic District, the House at 2312 South Summit Street was considered to be non-contributing to the District, due to the enclosing of the original front porch (see 1993 photograph below). Further alterations occurred to the property c.2000 after a fire extensively damaged the house (See c.2000 photograph below). These changes included the installation of replacement windows for about 60% of the windows and an altered roof pitch that was much shallower than it was originally. However, the house should now be considered to be a contributing resource. A recent project renovated the property closer to its original condition, installing more appropriate replacement windows, although the altered roofline did remain. As a result, the building is considered to be a contributing resource in the Central High School Neighborhood Historic District.
