In the second boundary increase nomination for the Central High School Neighborhood Historic District, which was listed on June 4, 2012, the House at 1501 South Summit Street was considered to be non-contributing to the District due to the installation of asbestos siding and the loss of the buildings original roofline and attic space. However, the house should now be considered a contributing resource. An ongoing project is working to restore the property. The original siding has been uncovered and is currently being repaired. In addition the roof and attic space are being redone. Although historic documentation for the property's original roofline does not exist, the roofline being constructed is based on similar houses in the neighborhood. As a result, the building is considered to be a contributing resource in the Central High School Neighborhood Historic District.
