Crystal Springs Historic District
Copiah County, Mississippi**

The Crystal Springs Historic District, Copiah County, Mississippi was listed on the National Register of Historic Places on March 10, 1997. The district contained 162 contributing resources, 66 noncontributing resources, and 4 resources previously listed on the National Register. The district was listed for association with Community Planning and Development, Commerce, and Architecture. The Period of Significance was 1857 to 1945.

Among the noncontributing buildings was the building located at 101 East Georgetown Street (Inv. 1), built c. 1900. The storefront of the building was altered with brick infill and a metal pent awning. In 2013, the owner completed a rehabilitation of the building, meeting conditions proposed by the National Park Service. The purpose of this amendment is to change the status of the building from noncontributing to contributing. There will be no change to the Areas of Significance, the Period of Significance or the boundaries of the district.
