The Marion Memorial Bridge located on U.S. 41 at Nickajack Lake (Tennessee River) in Haletown, Marion County, Tennessee was listed on the National Register on September 6, 2007. This steel 1,870-foot Parker and Warren Truss Bridge was constructed beginning in 1929 and finished in 1930 and was listed under Criteria A and C for its local significance in transportation, politics and government, and engineering for the time period of 1929-1947. The bridge was demolished beginning 2012 and ending in 2015 and replaced with a multi-span concrete deck girder bridge. As a result, the Marion Memorial Bridge has lost the significance for which it was listed and no longer retains integrity of setting, location, design, materials, workmanship, association and feeling. Therefore, the Marion Memorial Bridge should be removed from the National Register.








Figure 15: View to the southeast.
