The Ringgold Mill Complex was listed on the National Register on July 8, 1980. The mill complex was listed for its local significance in commerce and agriculture. The two primary buildings of the complex, the mill and grain elevator building, were demolished by the owners in September of 2012 due to hazardous safety issues and structural deterioration. As a result of the demolition of the two primary buildings of the complex, the Ringgold Mill Complex has lost the significance for which it was listed and no longer retains integrity of setting, design, materials, workmanship and feeling. Therefore, the Ringgold Mill Complex should be removed from the National Register.




Figure 1. Ringgold Mill Complex showing the Mill and the Grain Elevator.




Figure 6: Location of the Ringgold Mill Complex prior to demolition. The now demolished Mill and Grain Elevator are circled in black.
