Dear Ms. Shull,

Unfortunately, I must inform you that "Appleyard," the Stevenson Farm, Putnam County, Indiana, has been moved without consultation with the National Register of Historic Places. The property was listed in the National Register of Historic Places on February 23, 1990.

The house and carriage house were moved to an area about ¼ mile south of its original site several years ago. The historic barn was lost in the process. There are no historic buildings left on the property that was listed in the nomination. While DHPA intends to contact the owner about potentially re-listing the property, it is clear that the property should be removed from the National Register at this point in time, per CFR 60.14 (b) (4).

Since the property no longer exhibits any of the reasons for which it was listed, we are requesting that it be removed from the National Register. Please address any questions you or your staff may have about this nomination to my National Register staff, Paul Diebold or Holly Tate.
