Dear Mr. Gabbert:

The purpose of this letter is to notify you of our intent to delist the above property from the National Register of Historic Places. Originally listed on the Register on June 10, 1991, the above property was burned in September of 1992 and is currently an empty lot. Per 36 CFR 60, Sec. 60.15 (a)(1), we are requesting that the above property be officially delisted based on the fact that the property has ceased to meet the criteria for listing in the National Register because the qualities which caused it to be originally listed have been destroyed. To support this claim, we have included a letter sent to our office in 1992 informing us that the building had burned with a photograph as well as a Google street view image of the empty lot.

We have notified the property owner and the chief elected official and have included copies of those letters with this submission. No responses were received.
