

Obed Wild and Scenic River Rock Creek Campground Regulations

CAMPSITES

1. Camp in designated sites only.
2. Registered campers ONLY from 10:00 p.m. (ET) to 6:00 a.m. (ET)
3. QUIET HOURS ARE FROM 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
4. Driving nails, spikes, or screws into trees is prohibited.
5. Hanging lanterns from trees is prohibited.
6. Generators may be used in the campground between the hours of 10 a.m. and 8 p.m., so long as the use of such generators does not otherwise create unreasonable noise.

FOOD STORAGE

This is Black Bear habitat. Please help us keep the bears out of the campground by following the regulations. More information about the bears can be found at the Obed Wild and Scenic Visitor Center in Wartburg, TN.

1. All food, food items (mustard, ketchup, etc.), coolers (even if they are empty or have ice, water, pop, etc), must be kept in food storage locker or in a vehicle or trailer with hard sides, except while preparing or eating it.
2. All garbage must be disposed of anytime you are not at the site. Garbage must never be left out overnight.
3. Pick up all food scraps and wipe down tabletops. Also do not pour grease out in fire rings and do not leave dirty cooking utensils around.

SANITATION/REFUSE DISPOSAL

1. Do not burn trash, food scraps or oil in fire rings.
2. Dispose of dishwater only in pit toilets. Do not dump on ground.

CAMPFIRES/FIREWORKS

1. Collect only dead and downed wood for firewood.
2. The use of chainsaws is prohibited.
3. Build fires only in designated fire rings, and leaving campfire unattended is prohibited.
4. Using/possessing fireworks/explosive devices in the park is illegal.

ALCOHOL

Alcohol is prohibited in the campground

ANIMALS

1. Pets MUST be restrained on a leash not to exceed six feet.
2. Do not leave pets unattended!
3. Clean up pet waste and dispose of properly.

HUNTING/FIREARMS

1. Loaded weapons are prohibited in the campground.
2. Target practice of any kind is prohibited within the Obed Wild and Scenic River.

VEHICLES

1. No more than two motor vehicles or, alternatively, one vehicle with trailer are allowed per campsite.
2. ATV's are prohibited from being operated in the campground and on all paved roads.
3. Operators of diesel-fueled vehicles are prohibited from idling their engines within the park.
