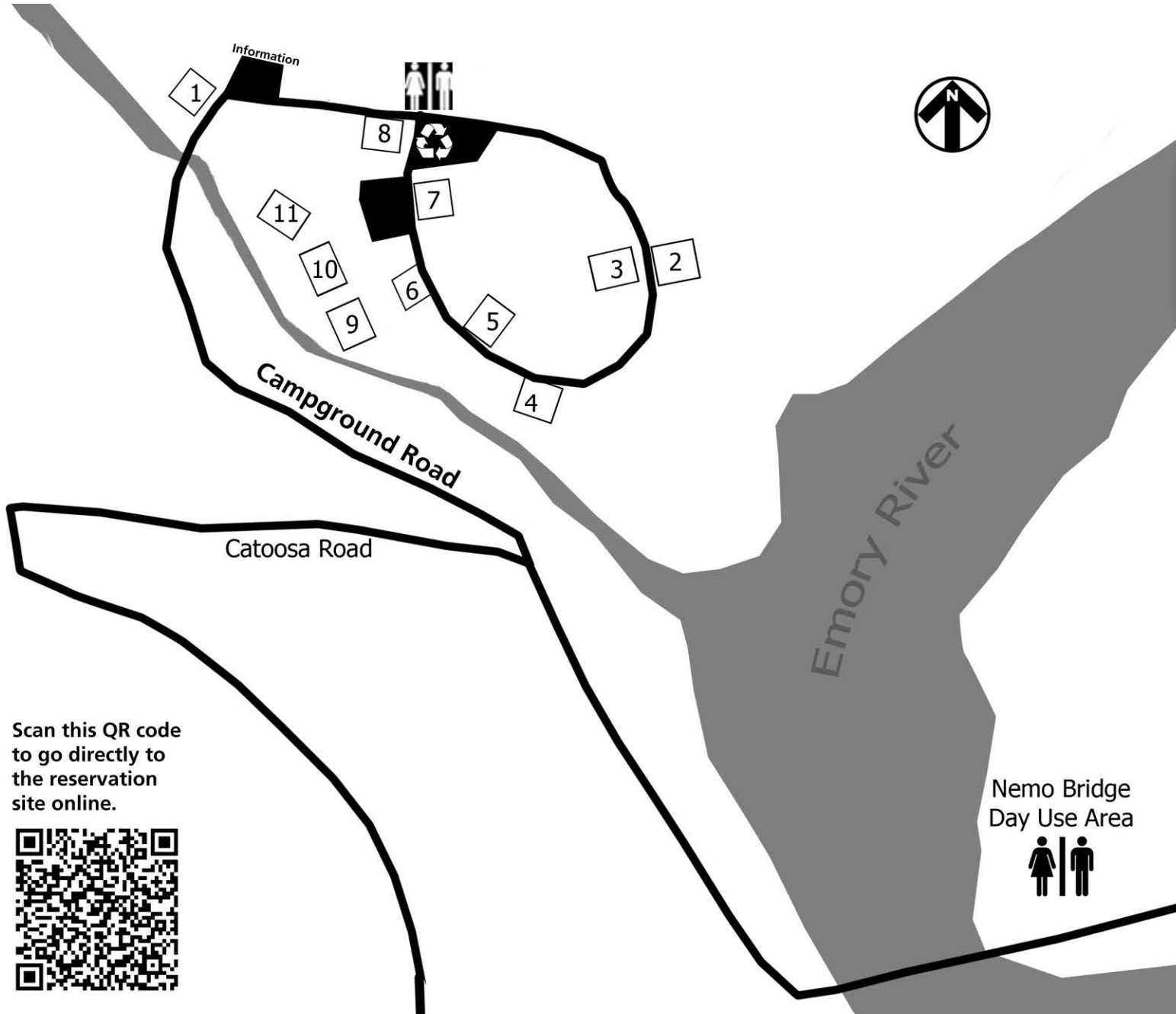

Rock Creek Campground Regulations

CAMPSITES

1. Campsites must be paid for online at www.recreation.gov, or by calling 1-877-444-6777. Payment may also be made in person at the Obed Visitor Center, located in Wartburg, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. ET, daily.
2. QUIET HOURS are 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
3. Driving nails, spikes, or screws into trees is prohibited.
4. Hanging anything from trees, including lanterns is prohibited.
5. You may not camp for more than 30 days total in a calendar year.
6. Registered campers ONLY from 10:00 p.m. (ET) to 6:00 a.m. (ET)
7. Only eight persons per campsite. All tents must fit onto the tent pads.
8. Generators may be used at the campground between the hours of 10:00 am and 8:00 pm, so long as use does not create unreasonable noise.

FOOD STORAGE

Obed is black bear habitat. Please help us keep bears out of the campground by following the regulations. More information about bears may be found at the Obed Wild & Scenic Visitor Center, in Wartburg, TN.

1. All food items, and coolers (even if they are empty or have ice, water, soft drinks, etc.), must be kept in a food storage locker, or in a vehicle or trailer with hard sides, except while preparing or consuming it.
2. All garbage must be disposed of anytime the campsite is unattended. Garbage must never be left out overnight.
3. Pick up all food scraps and wipe down tabletops. Also, do not pour grease out in fire rings and do not leave dirty cooking utensils around.

SANITATION/REFUSE DISPOSAL

1. Do not burn trash, food scraps, or oil in fire rings.
2. Dispose of dishwater in pit toilets only. Do not dump on ground.

CAMPFIRES/FIREWORKS

1. Chainsaw use is prohibited.
2. Using/possessing fireworks/explosive devices in the park is illegal.
3. Build fires only in designated fire rings. Leaving campfires unattended is prohibited.
4. Collect only dead and downed wood for firewood. Firewood originating from outside of Morgan and Cumberland Counties is prohibited.

ANIMALS

1. Do not leave pets unattended.
2. Clean up pet waste and dispose of properly.
3. Pets MUST be restrained on a leash not to exceed six feet in length.

HUNTING/FIREARMS

1. Hunters must keep their weapons unloaded in the safety zone around Rock Creek Campground.
2. Target practice of any kind is prohibited within Obed Wild & Scenic River.

VEHICLES

1. Vehicles must remain on paved surfaces at all times.
2. Rock Creek Campground is not suitable for recreational vehicles and camping trailers.
3. No more than two motor vehicles, or alternatively, one vehicle with trailer are allowed per campsite.
