FISHING REGULATION CORRECTIONS, Effective May 1, 2013. ONP sport fishing errata for brochure at www.nps.gov/olymp/fishing.htm:

- 1) Upper Hoh and South Fork Hoh Rivers closed to fishing from May 1–October 31. Open November 1 to April 15 with gear and daily limits as defined in Fishing Brochure.
- 2) Clarification: Pages 9-10, Zone 1 should read, "Dosewallips, Duckabush, Graywolf, North Fork Sol Duc, Sol Duc, South Fork Calawah, Quinault (East Fork, North Fork, and mainstem from ONP bridge upstream). *Elwha River closed to fishing, 2012-2017.*
- 3) Clarification: Pages 9-10, Zone 3-Quinault River (mainstem from ONP bridge downstream) is open from June 1–Mar. 31.
- 4) Clarification: Pages 9-10, Queets River, mainstem, below Hartzell Boat Launch. Sept.1–Nov. 30. Up to 2 salmon may be retained of which up to 2 may be adipose clipped hatchery Chinook salmon.
- 5) Clarification: Pages 9-10, Salmon River. Sept.1–Nov.30. Up to 3 salmon may be retained of which up to 2 may be adipose clipped hatchery Chinook salmon.
- 6) Hatchery steelhead and salmon may be caught and released until the daily limit is retained.
- 7) It is unlawful to completely remove salmon, steelhead, and bull trout/Dolly Varden from the water if it is unlawful to retain those species, or if the angler subsequently releases those fish.
- 8) Correction: Page 13, Canary rockfish daily limit is 0.
