Solar-Powered Cars *Rally in the National Parks*

The National Park Service turns 100 this year. In celebration, we're partnering with the Innovators Educational Foundation to showcase science innovation by hosting the 2016 American Solar Challenge. Teams from around the world will design and build solar-powered cars, and then drive them **1,800 miles** on the open road, visiting **9 national parks** in **7 Midwestern states**.

In caring for America's most treasured places, the National Park Service studies the effects of climate change on national park resources and provides education to the public.



Next Generation of Innovation

The Innovators Educational Foundation organizes the American Solar Challenge, a collegiate student competition to design, build, and drive solar-powered vehicles in a cross-country time-distance rally event.



The 8-day centennial event will take place from July 30 to August 6, 2016.
