### **HAPPENING NOW: Climate Watch, a bird monitoring citizen science opportunity**

On the heels of a recent [NPS-National Audubon Society study](#) of potential climate change-driven shifts in bird species distributions, Audubon is launching a new community science program to test the science and monitor for expected changes. [Climate Watch](#) surveys take place in the winter (January 15 - Feb 15) and in the summer breeding season (May 15 - Jun 15). The summer survey period has begun, and interested parties are encouraged to engage right away! Climate Watch emphasizes highly detectable birds for which the climate models have strong predictions, and therefore focuses participant efforts on two groups of species... [read more](#)
