I Philemon Chew Register of Wills for said County do hereby certify that the bearer here of negro John commonly called John Ganer a Dark coloured boy about twenty three years of age five feet seven and an half inches high, Having a scar in the middle of his Forehead caused from the throw of a stone, and a scar on the outside of his left leg below the knee occasioned by the bite of a dog who was born and raised on Mr. John H. DeButts farm near Alexandria in the county aforesaid is a free person and became entitled to his freedom by virtue of the Last Will and Testament of a certain Thomas S.
