COMPENDIUM AMENDMENT: 36 CFR 1.5

Designations, Closures, Permit Requirements and other Restrictions Imposed Under the Discretionary Authority of the Superintendent ... Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1.

AUTHORITY

Under the authority of 16 U.S.C. Section 3, and Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Parts 1-7, this Compendium of Superintendent's Orders is established for Ozark National Scenic Riverways. Regulations listed in this compendium are a requirement in addition to those listed in Parts 1-7 of Title 36 unless otherwise noted. The specific authority for this regulatory procedure is found in Sections 1.5, 1.6 and 1.7 of Title 36.

PART 1 – General Provisions

Section 1.5(a)(1) Closures and Public Use Limits:


Ozark National Scenic Riverways will be hosting a managed archery deer hunt December 12-14, 2014. The Big Spring Campground will be temporarily closed for the duration of the hunt, from December 11 at 12:00 p.m. to the morning of December 15. In addition, all trails within the Big Spring area will be closed unless otherwise posted.

The public was notified through two press releases, dated October 1 and November 26, 2014. In addition, the managed hunt was published in the *Missouri Department of Conservation 2014 Fall Deer & Turkey* booklet and the closure was posted on the park's website and Facebook page.


Determination: This objective of this hunt is to help manage high deer densities on NPS lands. Individuals participating in the hunt will be carrying and/or using compound bows. To ensure public safety the campground and trails will be closed to all park visitors.
