Alley Spring and Round Spring Campgrounds Closed for Paving Project at Ozark National Scenic Riverways

Eminence, MO – Beginning Monday, March 19, 2012 through 5:00 pm on Tuesday, May 1, 2012, the Alley Spring and Round Spring Campgrounds will be undergoing a paving project. For visitor safety, the venture requires the temporary closing of the campground.

The paving job will restore existing paved roadway surfaces in the Alley Spring and Round Spring Campground areas. Campsites can still be reserved for future dates throughout the roadway paving project. Call 1-877-444-6777 to make your reservations through Reserve America. All other park campgrounds are open.

Partial access to the Jacks Fork and Current Rivers will be maintained for floaters and boaters while the paving is underway. On weekends between March 19 and May 1, the Alley Spring Campground launch area will be opened from 12:01 a.m. Saturday morning through 11:59 p.m. Sunday evening. Jacks Fork floaters and boaters can continue to access the river at Burr Oak located at the picnic area near Alley Mill. The lower Round Spring River access via park route 169 will be open daily for Current River floaters and boaters.
