### Ozark National Scenic Riverways Reopens Alley Spring Campground after Paving Project Round Spring Campground Remains Closed

**Eminence, MO** – The Alley Spring Campground has been reopened for camping. The majority of the Alley Spring Campground paving project has been completed except for some minor roadwork.

The lower Round Spring River access via park route 169 will be open daily for Current River floaters and boaters.
