ATV & UTV REGULATIONS



The Following Federal (36 CRF) and Missouri State regulations apply within the boundaries of Ozark National Scenic Riverways. The Current and Jacks Fork rivers are National Park Service areas. It is our duty to protect our park visitors and the valuable park resources.

Please note the following ATV & UTV regulations, references, and assessed fines.

All ATV's shall be registered with the State and the registration sticker shall be attached to the right front fork of frame. All ATV's must have a permit from the county in which they are being operated.	RSMO 301.711	\$75.00
All ATV's must be equipped with an equilateral triangle emblem mounted on the rear of the vehicle. The emblem shall be constructed of substantial material with fluorescent yellow-orange finish and reflective, red border at least one inch in width. Each side of the emblem shall measure at least ten inches.	RSMO 307.198(2)	\$75.00
All ATV's must display a bicycle safety flag , which extends at least seven feet above the ground. The flag shall be triangular in shape with an area of not less than thirty inches and shall be day glow orange in color.	RSMO 304.013	\$75.00
All firearms carried on an ATV or UTV shall be unloaded when the vehicle is in motion.	36CFR 2.4 (a)	\$125.00

No person shall operate an ATV or UTV:

While a passenger on board (ATV only).	RSMO 304.013	\$75.00
At and unreasonable speed.	36CRF 4.22 (b) (1)	\$125.00
Excessive acceleration or braking.	36CRF 4.22 (b) (2)	\$75.00
Without a securely fastened helmet on the head of an individual who operates an ATV unless the individual is at least eighteen least of age.	RSMO 304.013	\$75.00

RSMO = State of Missouri

***Utility Vehicles (Mules/Rangers/Gators) are allowed in accordance with MO State Statue 304.032. Operators must have a valid driver's license and a county permit sticker to operate on county roads within the park boundary. Safety flags and triangles are not required.**
