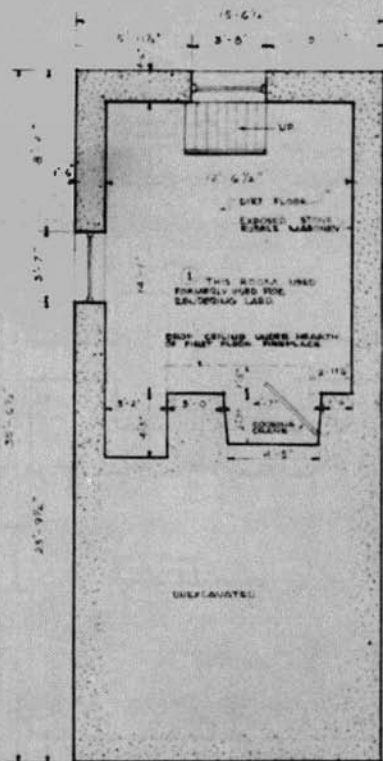


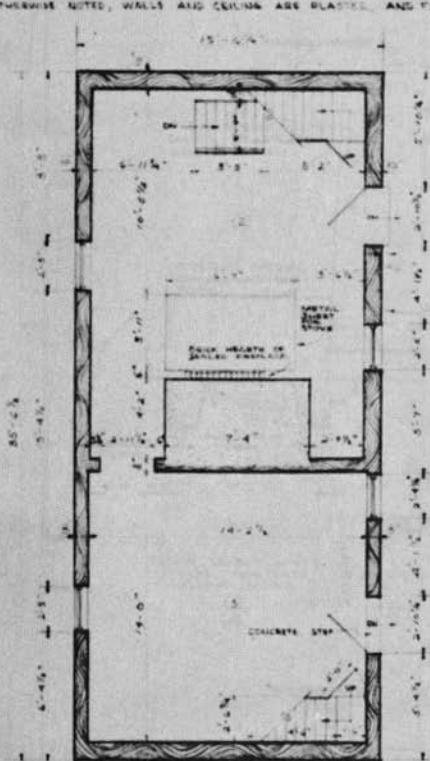

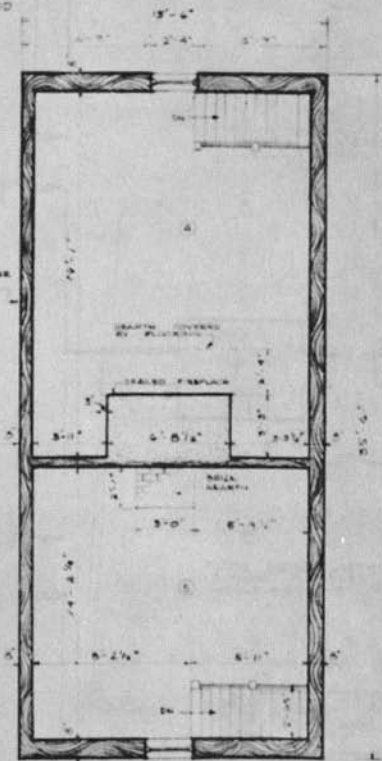
BASEMENT

SCALE : 1/4" = 1' - 0"



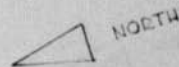
SECOND FLOOR
