




# International Archeology Day

### 9:30am McCreery Pueblo Hike

Join an archeologist for a hike to a small pueblo with an impressive kiva occupied around 1100 AD. This special site is only open to the public via guided tour! Roundtrip hike is 1 ½ mi (2.4 km) on uneven ground. Allow 2 ½ hours total. Be prepared with water, snacks, hat, sunscreen, and sturdy hiking shoes. Be prepared with water, hat, sunscreen, and sunscreen.
