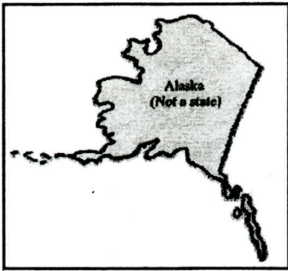


Travel Routes
