Accommodations

Water, wood, restrooms, and straw will be provided in the camp. A hospitality tent will also be available if you need something to drink and cool off away from the public.

Meals

Five meals will be available at the Boy Scout camp (Friday dinner; breakfast, lunch, and dinner Saturday; and Sunday breakfast). Again this year we will have the Pig Roast on Saturday night.



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Historic Weapons



Due to the current certification of the park's Historic Weapons Supervisors **only muskets and smooth bore non-chambered artillery** will be allowed to fire. Other weapons such as chambered artillery, rifles, or other special weapons may be brought for display purposes only. If you have any questions feel free to ask. Blank musket rounds will be provided by the NPS. For your artillery rounds bring your prepared foil (or former ready to roll) and we will schedule a time to fill your rounds together either Friday night or early Saturday Morning. You are allowed to bring your own quills for priming. All weapons to be demonstrated will need to

pass an NPS inspection as in previous years. This will **require muskets to have both flash guards and hammer stalls**. This year we will have a Military Tattoo to showcase any special skills of your unit. Again if you have any questions feel free contact Rob Whitman at robert_whitman@nps.gov .

Transportation

The Miller Ferry

The Miller Ferry is a passenger and vehicle ferry that leaves from Catawba (at the northern terminus of Ohio Route 53). It is the only boat line that transports vehicles. Vehicle loading is on a first-come, first-served basis. Boats run every half hour beginning at 6:30 a.m., with the last boat leaving Catawba at 8:30 p.m. (For more information call 1-800-500-2421 or visit www.millerferry.com)

The Jet Express

The Jet Express is a passenger ferry that operates from downtown Port Clinton. For more information on the Jet Express schedule visit www.jet-express.com or call 1-800-245-1538.

Important Information:

You **must** note on the registration form which ferry you will be using, the number of people in your group, and the number of vehicles you need to ferry to the island. Please also include the footage of any trailer you intend to bring on the ferry. Once we confirm your registration we will place your name on a list to be given to the staff at either the Miller Ferry or Jet Express. Give them your name at the ticket booth, and let them know that you are part of the Historic Weekend Camp at Perry's Victory. The park will take care of the bill. The expense of your ferry will be covered by the park, but it is essential we have a firm price of the complete cost of your trip as this event happens so close to the end of our federal fiscal year and the budget will already be set. Thank you for your cooperation on this issue.
