



The Battle of Lake Erie **Bicentennial Commemoration** Perry's Victory and International Peace Memorial

Re-enactor Registration for September 6 - 10, 2013

You are invited to participate in the commemoration of the 200th anniversary of the Battle of Lake Erie at Perry's Victory and International Peace Memorial. The commemoration begins on Friday, August 29 and concludes on the anniversary date of the battle, September 10th. We are seeking re-enactors from Friday, September 6 through Tuesday, September 10. Register by Tuesday, August 6, 2013.

We are offering incentives for re-enactors who can stay through September 10. If you stay through 6 p.m. on Sunday, September 8, you are eligible to receive a \$50 honorarium. Re-enactors staying through 6 p.m. on Monday are eligible for \$100 and those staying through 6 p.m. Tuesday, September 10 can receive \$150. Re-enactors staying these extra days also receive meals. Register soon to be eligible for these incentives as they are limited based on programming needs.

Accommodations

Water, wood, restrooms, and straw will be provided in the camp. Powder will be provided by the NPS in cartridge form. If you require other than 2F powder and/or plan on bringing an artillery piece, please note that below in your registration form.

Five meals will be available at the Boy Scout camp (Friday dinner; breakfast, lunch, and dinner Saturday; and Sunday breakfast). Meals provided for those staying beyond noon Sunday will be coordinated by Perry's Victory & International Peace Memorial.

Transportation

The Miller Ferry

The Miller Ferry is a passenger and vehicle ferry that leaves from Catawba (at the northern terminus of Ohio Route 53). It is the only boat line that transports vehicles. Vehicle loading is on a first-come, first-served basis. Boats run every half hour beginning at 6:30 a.m., with the last boat leaving Catawba at 8:30 p.m. (For more information call 1-800-500-2421 or visit www.millerferry.com)

The Jet Express

The Jet Express is a passenger ferry that operates from downtown Port Clinton. For more information on the Jet Express schedule visit www.jet-express.com or call 1-800-245-1538.

Do not pay the ferry and get a receipt!

Once we confirm your registration we will place your name on a list to be given to the staff at either the Miller Ferry or Jet Express. Give them your name at the ticket booth, and let them know that you are part of the Historic Weekend Camp at Perry's Victory. The park will take care of the bill.

Due to procedural changes, Perry's Victory no longer has the ability to reimburse re-enactors for mileage. Re-enactors will receive complimentary ferry travel and those able to stay through 6 p.m. on Sunday, Monday, or Tuesday, are eligible for a \$50 per day honorarium.
