Pipe Spring Transportation Grant Application

Summary

Pipe Spring is offering local schools financial assistance to help make field trips to the monument a possibility for 4th grade students.

Purpose

The National Park Service values its education mission to serve as a resource for teachers and students. In 2019 and 2020, Pipe Spring National Monument will be proud to host as many local students as possible for hands-on and immersive educational experiences during the 2019-2020 school year. Because transportation costs are often cited as the main obstacle for school field trips, the monument will use the grant to assist teachers in funding field trips they ordinarily would not be able to afford.

Eligibility requirements (For exceptions to any requirement, please contact Ranger Driscoll):

- 4th Grade Class
- Title 1 School
- Be located within Washington County, Kane County, Colorado City, or Fredonia
- Schedule a ranger-guided, curriculum-based program during your visit to Pipe Spring

- Complete post-field trip assessments and submit to Pipe Spring National Monument

Steps for Transportation Funding

1. Complete Application and send to Pipe Spring at the address in the left hand corner
2. Receive Approval confirmation from Pipe Spring
3. Submit approved application and commercial transportation invoice or school district transportation bill to Zion Natl Park Forever Project at address in the right hand corner
