CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	<p>Fire continues to burn southwest in a remote area of the Point Reyes National Seashore. Smoke continues to impact Marin and San Francisco counties.</p> <p>The incident received air support yesterday with 1 Copter, 1 Very Large Air Tanker, 3 Type 1 Tankers, and 1 Air Attack Plane.</p> <p>A Federal Management Team has been requested and is anticipated to transition on Sunday August 23rd with the current Interagency Type 3 Team. Personnel will continue to construct direct and indirect control lines.</p>
Evacuations:	An evacuation warning is issued in coastal sections of West Marin. The warning was directed to residents living and visiting west of Shoreline Highway (State Route 1) between Sir Francis Drake Boulevard in Olema south to Bolinas, a stretch of about 11.5 miles.
