

## Determination of Temporary Closure

### 36 CFR 1.5 Closures and Public Use Limits

(a) Consistent with applicable legislation and federal administrative policies, and based upon a determination that such action is necessary for the maintenance of public health and safety, protection of environmental or scenic values, protection of natural or cultural resources, aid to scientific research, implementation of management responsibilities, equitable allocation and use of facilities, or the avoidance of conflict among visitor use activities, the Superintendent may:

(1). Establish, for all or a portion of a park area, a reasonable schedule of visiting hours, impose public use limits, or close all or a portion of a park area to all public use or to a specific use activity.

<b>1. Temporary Closure Location:</b> McClure Beach Access Road, from Pierce Point parking lot.	
<b>2. Duration of Temporary Closure:</b> Until further notice	
<b>3. Who is affected by the Temporary Closure:</b> All vehicular traffic	
<b>4. Justification for Temporary Closure:</b> A portion of the road was washed out and collapsed during a series of storms in February and is impassable.
