

Determination of Temporary Closure

36 CFR 1.5 Closures and Public Use Limits

(a) Consistent with applicable legislation and federal administrative policies, and based upon a determination that such action is necessary for the maintenance of public health and safety, protection of environmental or scenic values, protection of natural or cultural resources, aid to scientific research, implementation of management responsibilities, equitable allocation and use of facilities, or the avoidance of conflict among visitor use activities, the Superintendent may:

- (1). Establish, for all or a portion of a park area, a reasonable schedule of visiting hours, impose public use limits, or close all or a portion of a park area to all public use or to a specific use activity.

1. Temporary Closure Location: North District Operations Center (NDOC) Access Road. This is also known as the Cypress Tree Tunnel Road.	
2. Duration of Temporary Closure: Until further notice	
3. Who is affected by the Temporary Closure: All non-administrative traffic.	
4. Justification for Temporary Closure: Recent storms have left the ground very saturated and off road travel has become a continual problem and has caused substantial damage. The access road will be closed until the ground dries out to prevent further damage.
