Attached are the documents as required by section 3.2.6 of the Consent Order. The section reads:

Harbor Seal Protection Areas. All of Respondent's boats, personnel, and any structures and materials owned or used by Respondent shall be prohibited from the harbor seal protection areas defined on the map, which is attached to this Consent Order as Figure 2. Within 60 days of issuance of this Consent Order, Respondents shall submit a plan outlining the removal of all equipment and materials located in these areas. Within 60 days of the approval of this plan by the Executive Director, Respondents shall implement the plan as approved. In addition all of Respondent's boats and personnel shall be prohibited from coming within 100 yards of hauled out harbor seals.

There are no equipment or materials located within the area defined on the Consent Order map as harbor seal protection areas. Therefore no plan for removal of equipment or materials from these areas is necessary. Drakes Bay Oyster Company will continue to maintain a minimum distance of 100 yards from hauled out harbor seals as it has in the past, pursuant to the 1992 interagency harbor seal protocols for Drakes Estero.
