



The Wildlife of the Newly Restored Giacomini Wetlands *Spring/Summer/Fall 2009*

Spring and the subsequent summer and fall brought new and old visitors to the restored wetlands. Pelicans, otters, and egrets returned to their old haunts, albeit in greater numbers. Bald eagles visited the site in both spring and early fall. The number of potentially breeding State-threatened California black rail was estimated at 3, the highest ever recorded in the Project Area.
