CURRENT SITUATION						
Situation Summary:	The fire continues to burn southwest in a remote area of the Point Reyes National Seashore. Smoke continues to impact Marin and San Francisco counties.					
	The incident received continued air support with copters, large air tankers, and to supper scooper fix wing aircraft that utilized Tomales Bay to load from. The incident has received additional ground resources.					
	A Federal Management Team is transitioning on Sunday, August 23rd, with the current Interagency Type 3 Team. Fireline personnel are continuing to construct direct and indirect control lines.					
Evacuations:	An evacuation warning is issued in coastal sections of West Marin.					
	 West of Shoreline Highway (State Route 1) between Sir Francis Drake Boulevard in Olema south to Bolinas. 					
	 West of Highway 1 and Sir Francis Drake Blvd (northern intersection) to the Point Reyes Lighthouse. This includes the communities of Olema, Inverness, Inverness Park and Sea Haven. 					
	 Sir Francis Drake to the Bay Area Ridge Trail, continuing to the Bolinas Ridge Fire Road and the McCurdy Trail – all areas west of those intersections. 					

	 Point Reyes National Seashore west of Highway 1 is now closed to all visitors, including the Point Reyes Lighthouse.
