Point Reyes is the windiest place on the Pacific Coast and the second foggiest place on the North American continent. The lighthouse, built in 1870 and retired in 1975, is now under management by the National Park Service. It is one of the few lighthouses in the United States which have the original Fresnel lens and clockwork mechanism in working order.
