Across the Golden State, invasive plants reduce plant diversity and wildlife habitat, consume needed water, reduce agricultural production and create fire hazards. Among the many types of plants that invade the California landscape, non-native thistle species are a major problem, especially in the state's grasslands.

How Can You Help?

- **LEARN** to identify invasive plants in your area
- **REPORT** weed sightings to the land manager or local weed group
- **SUPPORT** local, state and federal efforts to control invasive weeds
