

Help Protect Elephant Seals
Stay at least 50 yards (46 meters) from any marine mammal. The Drakes Beach elephant seal pupping area is closed to all entry due to seal activity at all times of the year. The beach areas between the pupping area and Chimney Rock are closed to all entry from December 1 through March 31 during the pupping season, as is Fish Docks access road.

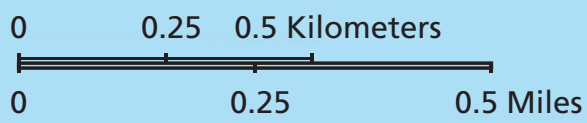
Drakes Bay

Steep Cliffs
The cliffs of the Chimney Rock Headlands are likely to crumble and slide. Stay behind fencing. Walking near the edge or climbing on cliffs invites catastrophe. Because of falling rocks, walking below cliffs is dangerous. Keep away!

Use only official, designated trails as shown.

Cliff and tidepool areas are closed to all entry on the south side of the Point Reyes headlands between Chimney Rock and the Lighthouse.
