Closures, restrictions and public use limits:

Lifting of Closure Order – Portion of a Park Area: Under the authority provided to the Superintendent of Redwood National and State Parks and under authority of Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 1.5(a) and Section (a)(1), Closure Order # 20-007, dated July 23, 2020 is rescinded, in part. All park areas not specified as closed are accessible to park visitors.

The following park areas and facilities remain closed until further notice:

- Klamath River Overlook parking lot and toilets
- High Bluff parking lot and toilets
- Alder Camp parking at Klamath Beach Road
- Flint Ridge parking lot
- Flint Ridge backcountry campsite

Restrictions and Public Use Limits: Under the authority provided to the Superintendent of Redwood National and State Parks and under authority of Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 1.5(a) and Section (a)(1), the following activities in Redwood National and State Parks that were restricted by Closure Order 20-003, dated May 21, 2020, remain restricted until further notice:

- Individuals may recreate outside for purposes of exercise provided they are maintaining social distancing of 6 feet.
- Individuals shall not congregate in groups of 11 or more at any time. Smaller groups are recommended in order to maintain appropriate social distancing practices.
