




Indian Lore Badge

Brief Description

The Indian Lore badge was created in 1931 by the Boy Scouts of America. The Indian Lore badge teaches scouts facts and traditions about different cultures of Native Americans.

Outcomes of the Program

1. The scouts will learn how to make and use prehistoric weapons and tools.
2. The scouts will learn the artifacts that was excavated and Russell Cave National Monument.
3. The scouts will learn how Native Americans hunted.
4. The scouts will learn how a tribe cooked and prepared food.
5. The scouts will learn three games played by the Native Americans. But the scouts will only demonstrate one.



Native Americans used several different methods to process food. One method was using a tool called the grinding stone. The grinding stone was a hollowed out rock that was used with a hammer stone to grind or process food material such as corn or walnuts.
