Directions to Old Fort Marcy

Fort Marcy is located on a hill northeast of historic downtown Santa Fe. From downtown, pedestrians can walk to the Cross of the Martyrs to access the site. If driving, follow these directions to the park. Fort Marcy or Prince Park is called Hillside Park on some maps. *There are **NMDOT detours** and road work underway.*

- From I-25, take St. Francis Drive north
- Turn right onto the second Paseo de Peralta
- Turn left onto Old Taos Highway
- Turn right onto Murales Road
- Turn right onto Bishops Lodge Road
- Turn left onto Artist Road
- Turn right onto Prince Avenue
- Park along Prince or Kearney Avenues
