Saint-Gaudens National Historic Site Blow-Me-Down Farm Site Management Plan Draft Alternatives

Cornish, New Hampshire — The National Park Service (NPS) is pleased to announce the release of draft management alternatives for the Blow-Me-Down Farm located within Saint-Gaudens National Historic Site. The alternatives, or options for how the National Historic Site will protect the farm's resources while providing a quality visitor experience, are part of a Site Management Plan which will establish a vision for the farm and provide guidance for its management.

The NPS has created a newsletter that describes the planning process and draft management alternatives.
