

**Saguaro National Park  
Centennial Saguaro Survey – Plot 24  
March 8, 2016

Volunteers from the Far Horizons Tanque Verde Hiking Club and Southern Arizona Rescue Association collected data from plot 24, which was established in 1990. Each column in the graph below indicates how many saguaros were counted. The columns show a size range, from smallest to largest. The light blue columns represent the saguaros FHTV Hiking Club & SARA monitored. Comparing the data from past surveys, there has been a slight decrease in the saguaro population on plot 24. Even though the plot decreased in saguaro population, plot 24 is one of our most dense saguaro plots in the Rincon Mountain District. Plot 24 also has the most germination at the Rincon Mountain District. Thank you FHTV Hiking Club & SARA for participating in a saguaro survey and we hope you learned more about the ever changing saguaro cactus forest!
