Job Description:

This intern (possibly two interns) will work on a variety of wildlife camera projects, particularly the “Lost Carnivore” program in the Tucson Mountain District. Duties may include: photo data summaries and analysis; field work; environmental education; working with neighbors and partners on regional monitoring programs.

The ideal candidate will have some or all of the following: detailed-oriented, comfortable with computers, capable of field work, and enjoy working with a diverse group of people, including children. Spanish speaking and writing ability is a definite plus.
