


Saguaro National Park - Saguaro Census Plot #37

Saguaro Plot #37



In this figure, green columns are the number of saguaros counted in 1990, red columns are the ones counted in 2000, yellow are the saguaros counted in 2007, and blue columns are the ones we counted in 2009. Each column represents a size range, with small ones (less than 1 meter tall) on the far left side and large ones to the right, with the total number on the far right. There has been an increase of more than 100 saguaros on the plot since 2000.
