

## Results of 2020 Saguaro Census on Plot 42, Tucson Mountains

Adventure Scientists, December 13-14<sup>th</sup>, 2019



On December 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>, we took out a small group of Adventure Scientists to Plot #42, just southwest of Safford Peak. This group signed themselves up for a tough couple of days working on a steep plot dense with saguaros. This groups was rewarded for their hard work with beautiful views and an interesting landscape with pretty rocks. On top of that, they counted 599 saguaros, 49 more than found in 2016! The other years this survey was conducted, in 1990 and 2000, this plot had 256 and 299 respectively. We found 18 saguaros under 10 centimeters with the smallest one coming in at 1 cm!
