Tucson, AZ – Saguaro National Park is offering a one-day Junior Ranger Explorer Camp for kids 7 to 10 years old on March 30th in the Tucson Mountain District (TMD – west). This Explorer Camp will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m and will includes a variety of fun and engaging activities designed to connect children with the desert environment.
