### **Saguaro National Park Passes Are Now Available Online**

Saguaro National Park is pleased to announce that Weekly and Annual Pass sales are now available online at [www.nps.gov/sagu](http://www.nps.gov/sagu), by clicking on the "Fees and Reservations" tab.

The Saguaro National Park Annual Pass allows entry for the pass owner and their guests in a single private vehicle or up to 4 adults by foot or bicycle for 12 months for only \$25. The Saguaro National Park Weekly Pass allows entry for the pass owner and their guest in a single private vehicle or 2 adults by foot or bicycle for 7 days for only \$10. Both passes are accepted at the Rincon and Tucson Mountain Districts.

"We realize that it may not be convenient for all visitors to come in to the visitor centers to purchase an annual pass or entry fee into the park," said Darla Sidles, Superintendent of Saguaro National Park. "This makes it easier for hikers, bikers and other visitors to plan ahead or gift an annual pass while supporting their national park. Every dollar collected in Saguaro National Park stays in the park to help us maintain trails, restore exhibits, and provide other services to the visitors who use the park, and the passes make great gifts for friends and family living or visiting Tucson."
