SELF-GUIDED ACTIVITIES

Nature Trail

Start at the trailhead (adjacent to the Old Orchard Museum) and follow our unpaved, loop trail down to the water and back! The trail is available to enjoy from sunrise to sunset, stretches 0.7 miles, and experiences an elevation change of ~100 feet. Cross Eel Creek Bridge to the Beach at Cold Spring Harbor. **

Old Orchard Museum

Visit the museum's three exhibits rooms and learn about Theodore Roosevelt's life. Open from 11am-4:30pm, the museum houses the park bookstore,

restrooms, and water fountains. Masks are required.*
