College Positions:

(August, 2013)

Many positions are closed due to funding issues. Check back from time to time to see the status. Current students and recent graduates are eligible. Applicants must be US citizens or permanent residents. Applications accepted for only one position at a time. Housing may be available for full time interns. A small stipend (\$20 per workday) may be available. All interns must have their own transportation to and from work.

- Carnivore Biology Internship – Closed, may open in November.
