Since its inception in 1916, the National Park Service has been dedicated to the preservation and management of this country's outstanding natural, historical, and recreational resources. Today, the National Park Service encompasses 390 sites across the United States and in Guam, Saipan, Samoa, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands. There are parks of great natural beauty and grandeur, such as the Grand Canyon, Denali, and Yellowstone; parks that preserve the nation's cultural and historical treasures, such as the White House, Bandelier, Canyon de Chelly, and Gettysburg Battlefield; and parks of significant national beauty along seashores, lakeshores, and riverways, providing opportunities for outdoor activities, such as Cape Hatteras, Assateague Island, and Lake Mead.
