Public Input Requested about Proposed Increases for Large Group Campsite Fees in Kings Canyon National Park

Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks is seeking input about proposed price increases for three large group campsites in the Cedar Grove area of Kings Canyon National Park. The campsites (-sites A, C, and D), which accommodate 20-40 people each, are located in Canyon View Campground. The increase would raise the price of each campsite from \$40 per night to \$50 per night to bring the price structure into alignment with other similar large campsites in the parks. **Public comments must be received by March 24, 2013** and may be submitted in two ways.
