### Program Descriptions

#### **Critter Talk**

30 minutes. Meet at the Lodgepole Visitor Center. Discover more about the animals that call Sequoia National Park home.

#### **Scat & Tracks Talk**

30 minutes. Meet at the Lodgepole Visitor Center. Investigate the clues just like a crime scene investigator would and discover what animals you may find in the forest.

#### **Snowshoe Walk**

2 hours. 1 mile. Join a ranger for a snowshoe walk through the winter woods on old fashioned wooden snowshoes provided. No snowshoe experience necessary. All participants should wear waterproof footwear and dress warmly. Not recommended for children under the age of 10. Reservations required; limit 18 participants.
